Henry VIII suffered no invasion by European powers though the French threatened to land on several occasions Naval intelligence, therefore, was vital Threatened by invasion in 1487 Henry VII ordered Richard Edgewood's ships from Cornwall to shadow the fleet of the earl of Lincoln and Francis Lovell

#### **Thomas Cromwell and the Vicegerency in Spirituals: A ...**

HISTORICAL orthodoxy asserts that Henry VIII, once he had assumed the title of supreme head of the English church, appointed Thomas Cromwell as his vicegerent in ecclesiastical matters The vicegerency is seen as the instrument of the royal supremacy The two go together: the appointment of a vicegerent in spirituals was the first act of the
