psychoanalytic theorists, Melanie Klein and Wilfred Bion Both are notoriously complex, difficult, and rewarding authors who were primarily working clinicians, deeply concerned with figuring out how to help their patients get better Klein was the first psychoanalytic theorist to take envy seriously and make it central to her theory (1957)
